Inmate Telephone Use

There is a telephone available in each block of the Oneida County Jail. All calls made on these telephones are collect. New arrestees will receive (1) telephone call from the booking area telephone for the purpose of securing bond at the time of booking. All phone calls from that point will be done on the collect telephones. Inmates may purchase prepaid telephone cards once a week to be used with the Oneida County Jail telephone system. The telephone cards will be handed out on commissary days.

Telephone calls are recorded and may be subject to monitoring. Calls to the Public Defender in Rhineland are free and are not recorded. If an attorney requests to have their telephone number marked private so it is not recorded or monitored they must contact the jail.

The inmate telephone system of the Oneida County Jail is operated by Evercom. If you have problems with this system, please contact **Evercom Friends and Family at (800) 844-6591**.

The Oneida County Jail does not accept non-emergency, incoming telephone calls for inmates. In addition, we will not forward non-emergency messages to inmates.
