## NEWS RELEASE

For Immediate Release – August 1, 2017

City of Rhinelander- On Sunday, July 30, 2017, at approximately 1:16 a.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's Office 911 Center received a 911 call from a subject reporting that an unoccupied Oneida County Sheriff's Office squad parked in front of 28 North Brown Street in the City of Rhinelander had been damaged by a brick that appeared to have been thrown from the top of the building. The vehicle sustained approximately \$6,800 in damage.

The Rhinelander Police Department is conducting an investigation into events surrounding the incident. There is currently a reward of \$1,300 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this damage.
