For Immediate Release – September 15, 2017

The subject that was operating the motorcycle has passed away as a result of his injuries. Subject was identified as 26-year-old Charles S. Eye of Rhineland, Wisconsin.

Town of Pelican- On Thursday, September 14, 2017, at approximately 3:41 p.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's 911 Center received a 911 call from a subject reporting a motorcycle versus truck accident on County Highway P. The operator of the motorcycle was transported to Saint Mary's Hospital and was transported by Spirit to a hospital outside of the area.

The initial investigation indicates the motorcycle was traveling east bound when it entered the westbound lane of traffic and struck a vehicle. The motorcycle then struck another vehicle in the westbound lane and crashed in the ditch area.

Oneida County Deputies were assisted by the Pelican 1st Responders, Pelican Fire Department, and Oneida County Emergency Medical Services. This investigation is ongoing. Any questions should be directed to Chief Deputy Daniel Hess.
