HUBER TRANSFER

Per Wisconsin State Statute 303.8(6), in order for an individual to transfer a jail sentence, the sentencing court must authorize transfer. All transfer requests must originate from the county of commitment. All applicants applying to transfer to Oneida County must also see Huber rules for further information, forms and fees. Oneida County does not allow transfers to agencies participating in bracelet programs.
