For Immediate Release – July 3, 2018

On June 10, 2018, the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received a call reporting a sexual assault that occurred in the Town of Pelican. Initial information was that a male subject entered into the residence and physically and sexually assaulted the elderly female occupant.

Due to the circumstances, a physical description of the suspect was not available. Oneida County Sheriff's Detectives worked diligently to identify the suspect using DNA evidence. The Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory processed the DNA samples and we identified the person who we believe committed this crime as Isaiah Moren, 21 years old of Rhinelander.

Moren has been in custody since early in the investigation on a probation hold. The Oneida County Sheriff's Office anticipates arresting Moren and forwarding charges that include Burglary, Battery to an Elderly Person, First Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, First Degree Sexual Assault, and Strangulation to the Oneida County District Attorney's Office.
