On September 12, 2018, several arrests were made related to an investigation involving the manufacture of methamphetamine. The following were arrested in relation to the investigation: Richard S. Cody 41, Jennifer L. Davis 43, Bridgette L. Towne 36, of Rhinelander, and Allan J. Bronk 39 of Minocqua; on September 13, 2018 a search warrant was executed at 3323 Candy Lane in the Town of Pelican; the investigation continues and other arrests may be made.

The following agencies assisted in the investigation: North Central Drug Enforcement Group (NORDEG), Oneida County Sheriff's Office, Rhinelander Police Department, Wisconsin Department of Justice – Division of Criminal Investigation, Vilas County Sheriff's Office, Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, Pelican Fire Department and the Oneida County Ambulance Service.

Law enforcement continues to actively investigate persons involved with the manufacture/delivery of methamphetamine and encourages members of the community to contact their local law enforcement agency and report suspicious activity.
