## **NEWS RELEASE**

For Immediate Release – May 2, 2019

**TOWN OF CRESCENT, ONEIDA COUNTY, WI –** 05/01/2019 at approximately 11:45am the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received a report of a disturbance that occurred at an apartment complex on Overland Drive in the town of Crescent. Upon Deputies following up with the complaint it was reported that the male subject involved had discharged a firearm multiple times. A female that was in the residence was able to leave without being harmed. Upon speaking to the female, Sheriff's Deputies were informed that the incident actually occurred at around 10:30am.

Upon several unsuccessful attempts to make contact with the male subject in the apartment the Oneida County Special Response Team entered the residence at approximately 4:10pm. Inside there was one male subject that was deceased. The deceased male subject was identified as Anthony R. Sackett M/W 08/10/1992. It appears that Sackett suffered a self-inflicted gunshot wound. This incident is still under investigation. An autopsy is scheduled to be conducted.

Because of the location of the apartment complex in proximity of the Crescent Elementary School, the Oneida County Sheriff Deputies responded to Crescent School, and the school was placed on "Administrative Lock Down" as a precautionary measure. School staff and students were not in danger at any point during this incident.

The Oneida County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Oneida County Ambulance, Crescent 1<sup>st</sup> responders, and the Oneida County Medical Examiner's Office.
