For Immediate Release - Monday, June 24, 2019

Town of Sugar Camp- On Sunday, June 23, 2019 at approximately 2:22 p.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call of a vehicle versus tree crash on County Highway H. The caller reported that the vehicle was on fire. Citizens on scene attempted to get into the vehicle but were unable to due to the fire. Once the fire was extinguished, one person was found in the vehicle deceased. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Isaac Tessier, 16, of Sugar Camp.

Oneida County Deputies along with Vilas County Deputies, the Oneida County Ambulance, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the Sugar Camp Fire Department, the Wisconsin State Patrol, and the Oneida County Medical Examiner's Office responded to the scene. The Oneida County Sheriff's Office is completing the accident report. The Wisconsin State Patrol is completing a reconstruction of the accident.
