Recommended Routes Of Travel – In anticipation for the increased large vehicle traffic coming to the Hodag Country Fest, and the amount of construction in the Rhinelander area, the Oneida County Sheriff's Office is releasing a map with recommended routes of travel to the Hodag Country Fest grounds. Along with the recommended routes, the left turn signal from Highway 17N onto Stevens Street is being extended from 20 seconds to 40 seconds to allow RV's, trailers, and traffic ample time to turn safely onto the recommended route. There will be signs notifying traffic of the routes on July 9<sup>th</sup> through the 14th.
