For Immediate Release – Updated Saturday, August 31, 2019

Town of Sugar Camp- On Wednesday, August 28, 2019 at approximately 10:23 p.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call of a motorcycle in the middle of the roadway on Highway 17 North. The caller reported the person was not breathing. Upon arrival of emergency personnel, the operator of the motorcycle was found to be deceased. The motorcycle operator has been identified as Sean Holtslander, 23, of St. Germain, WI.

Jeffrey Liebscher, 53, of Sugar Camp, WI was arrested for Hit and Run Causing Death as well as Homicide by Negligent Use of a Vehicle on August 29, 2019.

As part of the investigation, Brian Liebscher, 54, of Sugar Camp was arrested on August 30, 2019 for Obstructing Law Enforcement by Providing False Information about his brother, Jeffrey Liebscher. When contacted on August 29, 2019 in the early morning hours, Brian did not report to law enforcement that Jeffrey had contacted Brian after the accident and that Brian had driven Jeffrey to Three Lakes after the accident. It is anticipated that Brian will be appearing in court on September 3, 2019.
