For Immediate Release – Tuesday, October 30, 2019

Town of Schoepke- On Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at approximately 7:30a.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call of vehicle crash on County Highway B near Meister Stockley Road. The driver called and stated that she went off the road and hit a tree sustaining head and foot injuries. A second 911 call was received stating that the car had also struck a male subject. The vehicle involved was a 2010 Subaru Impreza. The operator was transported by ambulance to St. Mary's Hospital. The male subject passed due to injuries sustained from the impact on the scene. That male was identified as Larry D. Badgley M/W of the town of Schoepke.

The Oneida County Sheriff's Office was assisted on scene by Fire District Alpha, Monico Fire Department, Oneida County Ambulance, and the Medical Examiner's Office. The Wisconsin Stated Patrol will be completing an accident reconstruction, and the Oneida County Sheriff's Office will be completing the accident report.
