For Immediate Release – Sunday, February 16, 2020

Town of Lake Tomahawk- On Friday, February 14, 2020 at approximately 6:09 p.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call of a south bound vehicle that had struck several parked vehicles along HWY 47. A total of 13 vehicles were struck, and they were all unoccupied. The vehicles were struck between Choate Blvd and Violet Dr.

Upon investigation of the incident the operator of the suspect vehicle, a 2017 Dodge Ram pickup, was identified as 52 year old Robert Allan Johnson of Thunder Bay, Ontario. Johnson was issued citations for Reckless Endangering Safety With A Motor Vehicle, Hit And Run Unattended Vehicle, Failure To Keep Vehicle Under Control, Inattentive Driving, Unsafe Lane Deviation, Disorderly Conduct With A Motor Vehicle, and Operating A Motor Vehicle Under the Influence. Johnson was also arrested for Felony 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety.

Johnson posted a \$7,166.80 bond and was released from custody on Saturday, February 15, 2020 with an initial appearance scheduled for Monday, February 17, 2020 at 1:15pm.
