Town of Woodboro- On Thursday, September 17, 2020 at approximately 10:14 a.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received multiple 911 calls of a two car head on accident at the intersection of Highway 8 West and County Highway N. Upon arrival, deputies found several people with injuries. The drivers of both vehicles were transported to the hospital by ambulance. The passenger of the westbound vehicle was transported by Medivac helicopter. The passenger of the westbound vehicle passed away enroute to the hospital. This passenger is now identified as 76-year-old Carol J. Brown of Tomahawk, WI.

The Oneida County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Nokomis Fire Department, Crescent Fire Department, Rhinelander Fire Department, Oneida County Emergency Medical Services, Rhinelander Medics 91, Medivac Helicopter Ambulance, Woodboro First Responders, Pine Lake First Responders, Oneida County Highway Department, Department of Transportation, Wisconsin State Patrol and the Oneida County Medical Examiners Department.
