UPDATED

On Monday, July 11, 2022, the Oneida County Sheriff's Office received four 911 phone calls from the area of Tesomas Scout Camp. During three calls, no information was provided by the caller. During one of the calls the caller stated someone had a gun and hung up. The 911 Communications Center attempted to call the phone number back but no one answered the phone. Tesomas Scout Camp staff were contacted. The camp was locked down and there was a large response from law enforcement. Upon arriving to the area where the phone call was made, it was determined there was no emergency. The investigation is ongoing.

Further investigation has revealed that the involved party is a child under the age of 12. The Department of Social Services with the corporation of the parents will be addressing the issue with the child.
