## **Huber Transfer Request**

Per Wisconsin State Statute §303.8(6), in order for an individual to transfer a jail sentence, the sentencing court must authorize transfer. All transfer requests must originate from the county of commitment. All applicants applying to transfer to Oneida County must also see Oneida County Huber Rules for further information, forms, and fees. Oneida County does not allow transfers to agencies participating in bracelet programs.

The form below must be filled out completely. Incomplete requests will not be processed.

There is a **\$30.00** fee for each Huber Transfer request. Fees need to be paid when this request is turned in or mailed to the Oneida County Sheriff's Office.
