For Immediate Release – Wednesday, April 10, 2024

On Wednesday, April 10, 2024 at approximately 9:30am the Oneida County Sheriff's Office was informed by the Wausau Police Department of a stolen silver 2003 Ford F150. The Oneida County Sheriff's Office was also informed the operator of the stolen F150, 36 year old Zach Tesky of Merrill, WI, was involved in a shooting in Wausau, WI.

At approximately 11:00am the Marathon County Sheriff's Office stated that the vehicle was reported being seen east bound on HWY 8 in the town of Pelican. Oneida County Deputies were able to locate the vehicle and followed it to a residence on Beaver Creek Road in the Town of Pelican. At 11:23am Oneida County Sheriff's Office Deputies were able to arrest Zach Tesky. Zach Tesky was later turned over to the Wausau Police Department.
