For Immediate Release – June 19, 2025

On Wednesday June 18, 2025 at 8:37 PM Oneida County Sheriff's Office received multiple calls of a single vehicle accident at the intersection of County Highway Highway K and Mitchell Lane in the Town of Nokomis. Oneida County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the scene. Initial investigation showed that a 1986 Chevy Corvette, operated by a 20 year old male, Gabriel M. Wallmow of Rhinelander, was westbound on County Highway K. Witnesses stated that they were passed by the corvette, and it was traveling at a high rate of speed. The driver lost control of the vehicle and it entered the northern ditch, went airborne, rolling several times. Wallmow, the sole occupant of the corvette, was ejected during the crash. Wallmow was transported by Oneida County ambulance to Tomahawk Aspirus Hospital, and later flown to Aspirus Wausau Hospital by LifeLink III helicopter.

The investigation is ongoing and the accident report will be completed by the Wisconsin State Patrol with assistance of the Oneida County Sheriff's Office.

On scene assisting the Oneida County Sheriff's Office were personnel from the Wisconsin State Patrol, Oneida County Ambulance Service, Nokomis First Responders, Nokomis Fire Department, Cassian Fire Department, and the Oneida County Highway Department.
