For Immediate Release – February 26, 2026

On Wednesday February 25, 2026 at 10:14 PM, the Oneida County Sheriff's Office was notified of a snowmobile accident on a trail off Lyannas Road in Lake Tomahawk. It was reported that a 55-year-old male had struck a tree and was not breathing. A second operator at the scene performed CPR on the injured rider until emergency medical personnel arrived. The injured rider was transported by ambulance to Howard Young Medical Center to be transported by Medevac. The second snowmobile operator, Robert Bauer, 60, was arrested for operating a snowmobile while intoxicated.

The Oneida County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Lake Tomahawk Fire Department, the Newbold Fire Department, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, and the Oneida County Ambulance.
