For Immediate Release- Update May 6, 2026

The passenger Ronald D. Miller listed below was not the correct passenger injured in the UTV accident. Miller was with the group of riders and was on scene but not injured. The injured person of the UTV accident is 70-year old Robert J Ogle of Antioch, Illinois. Ogle was treated for minor injuries on scene and released.

For Immediate Release – May 4, 2026

On Saturday May 2, 2026 in the Town of Enterprise, at approximately 5:28 P.M. the Oneida County Sheriff's Office responded to a call of a UTV vs tree. The crash was located a half mile south of trail intersection 266 off of Bowman Road. Upon arriving on scene, deputies located the operator who was identified as 70 year-old David R. McMillen of Salem, Wisconsin. McMillen was operating a 2024 Polaris UTV which struck a tree and he was pronounced deceased at the scene. The passenger of the UTV was 57 year-old Ronald D. Miller of Bristol, Wisconsin who was treated for minor injuries on scene and released.

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is completing the accident report.

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Crescent Fire Department, Fire District Alpha, Oneida County Medical Examiner, and Oneida County Ambulance assisted the Oneida County Sheriff's Office at the scene.
